RULES:

Competition run under Pony Club Rules (check website for rules). Ponies and horses to be correctly tacked up and riders appropriately dressed for all classes. Christmas jumpers, Pony Club sweatshirts or jackets may be worn. **Non PC Competitors must have 3rd Party Cover and sign accordingly.**

Standard SJ Classes: There will be two rounds, the second will be against the clock straight after your clear round.

Horse and Hound: Each rider will firstly complete the course mounted from the starting block then return for the groom to hold the pony and pass over the hound/dog to run the course with. The winner will be judged based on the quickest double clear round. Each fault (knock down/runout /refusal) incurs a 3 second time fault.

Top Score: Plan your own course, each jump has a score and whoever gets the highest points in 60 seconds, wins. The bell will be sounded to advise jockey that 60 seconds are up. You can jump each jump 4 times, the bigger the jump the higher the score. If you knock a fence down then you can't jump that one again and it's a 0 score. A refusal will not lose points, only time and you can try again without penalty.

Scurry: will be single phase with the fastest combined time winning.

Relay: Will be a tag team of two – first rider starts from the Start box completes the course and returns to start box to pass a whip or similar to the next rider. Dropped whips can be passed from the ground. The round of first rider's course may be completed by the second rider following retirement through injury, a

rider fall or three cumulative refusals (or vice versa). No horse may compete on more than one team. The winning team is the fastest with the fewest knock down penalties.

Chase me Charlie: Single Jump, which increases in height every time it's jumped. You must jump clear to continue up the heights. Winner is whoever jumps the highest clear.

REGULATIONS

All competitors must wear Pony Club Approved Riding Hats. These are PASO15:1998 or 2011 with BSI Kitemark, VG1 with BSI Kitemark, Snell E2001 with the Official Snell label and No. ASTM-F1163 2004a onwards with SEI mark, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards with chinstraps fastened whenever mounted. If your hat does not carry an official PC Turquoise "tag" please bring hat to the secretary for checking and tagging. BE or BRC Turquoise tags also accepted.
